## Secondary Supply List

All <u>required</u> supplies needed by secondary students are available from the school student supply closet free of charge. The students may pick them up on the first day of school. If your student wants to purchase PREFERRED supplies, then this list will help them select what they need.

ALL teachers will explain their class supply needs during the first few days of class.

They may add to, edit, or delete from this list. Students should be prepared to update their supplies.

Notebooks/notebook paper should be wide-ruled. NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS\*!

School issued water bottles and jackets/hoodies will be provided for the secondary students. Please do NOT purchase non-school issued water bottles for use in the secondary.

Recommended for all secondary grades (7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>):

- 1 BACKPACK (not provided by the school)
- 1 GYM BAG for 7<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> PE or basketball (not provided by the school)

- 2 LARGE PKGS. WIDE RULED PAPER
- 8 WIDE-RULED COMPOSITION NOTEBOOKS
- 1 ZIPPER POUCH FOR PENS AND PENCILS
- 1 PKG. regular ballpoint BLACK or BLUE PENS
- 2 PKGS. #2 PENCILS (wooden or mechanical)
- 1 LARGE WHITE ERASER (polymer)
- 1 PKG. 3X5 RULED INDEX CARDS
- 1 PKG. 4X6 RULED INDEX CARDS
- 1 COMPASS, 1 SMALL PROTRACTOR, 1 RULER (for math classes)
- 1 PKG. GRAPH PAPER
- 1 set of EAR BUDS (wired)
- 1 USB FLASH DRIVE
- 1 SCIENTIFIC CALCULATOR for 9<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> grades (the school supplies TI-30Xa models) NO GRAPHING CALCULATORS!
- SCIENCE FAIR SUPPLIES (budget for purchase of a board and supplies in January)
